Engagement methods that were suggested by the Board for consideration in the meeting: SH stated that Regal will be holding public engagement workshops from January onwards. Support was shown for the creation of an online platform to allow people to engage digitally. However, the Board also identified that there is a need to have a physical and regular presence on the high street throughout the project's development. It was suggested that the Developer consider their options and come back to the board and share proposed approach. An idea was proposed by board to consider taking on a vacant unit on the high street to ensure regular in-person engagement. There was also recognition that varied communication methods at various points were required to ensure accessibility and visibility. Key to this was awareness, and the need to
