## Notice of Interim Review of Polling Districts and Polling Places

Notice is hereby given that the London Borough of Barnet is undertaking a review of polling districts and polling places for use at all statutory elections held within the borough.

The review will commence on **Monday 31 July 2023** and will be completed in sufficient time to enable the Electoral Registration Officer to make any alterations necessary to the register of electors before the Full Revised Register is published on **Friday 1 December 2023**.

The Acting Returning Officer for the three Parliamentary constituencies represented within the borough will make a proposal in relation to all current polling districts and polling places. A copy of the Acting Returning Officer's proposals will be available on the council website ([www.barnet.gov.uk](http://www.barnet.gov.uk)) or may be obtained from Electoral Services, London Borough of Barnet, 2 Bristol Avenue, Colindale, London NW9 4EW or by emailing [electionsprojectoffice@barnet.gov.uk](mailto:electionsprojectoffice@barnet.gov.uk) or phoning 020 8359 5577.

The London Borough of Barnet invites the views of all residents, and particularly disabled residents, on any existing polling district and/or polling place. Any person making a representation where a change to an existing polling place is being proposed should, if possible, give alternative places that may be used as a polling place.
