1. An election is to be held for a Member of Parliament for the above Parliamentary constituencies.
2. Nomination papers to stand as a candidate in these elections are available at www.electoralcommission.org.uk or from the office of the Acting Returning Officer:
London Borough of Barnet, 2 Bristol Avenue, Colindale, London NW9 4EW on working days between the hours of 10am and 4pm.
3. Completed nomination papers must be delivered to the Acting Returning Officer, London Borough of Barnet, 2 Bristol Avenue, London NW9 4EW on any weekday following the date of this notice, between the hours of 10am and 4pm, **but no later than 4pm on Friday 7 June 2024**.
4. A deposit of **£500** must be paid by bank transfer, bankers draft or cash. Cleared funds must be received by **4pm on Friday 7 June 2024**. Please contact electionsprojectoffice@barnet.gov.uk for further information.
5. If the election is contested, the poll will take place on **Thursday 4 July 2024** between the hours of **7am and 10pm**.
6. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer no later than **Tuesday 18 June**. Applications should be made online at www.gov.uk/register-to-vote.
7. Applications to vote by post, or to change existing postal or proxy voting arrangements, must reach the Electoral Registration Officer **by 5pm on Wednesday 19 June 2024**. Applications for a postal vote can be made online at www.gov.uk/apply-postal-vote
8. New applications to vote by proxy must reach the Electoral Registration Officer **by 5pm on Wednesday 26 June**. Applications for a proxy vote can be made online at www.gov.uk/apply-proxy-vote
9. Applications to vote by emergency proxy, for circumstances arising *after 5pm on Wednesday 26 June 2024*, must reach the Electoral Registration Officer **by 5pm on Thursday 4 July**.
10. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificates or Anonymous Elector Documents must reach the Electoral Registration Officer in the local authority where the elector is registered **by 5pm on Wednesday 26 June 2024**. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate can be made online at www.gov.uk/apply-for-photo-id-voter-authority-certificate
