LBB Building Materials FAQ's (383)

Q1.	Who needs one?
Α.	Wherever there is building works occurring that use the highway For example:
	 Shops with scaffold up on the footpath Cranes working on loft conversions For cranes we issue an indemnity not a licence however it follows the same procedure as a licence, costs etc are all the same. Hoarding fencing off a site from the footway
	Building materials being stored on the highway, We grant building materials licences for a 3 month period only if further extensions are required, additional fees and deposit apply and are at the discretion of the Highways Inspector.
Q2.	How much does it cost?
Α.	You will need to pay an admin fee and a deposit in case of any damage: Licence Fee: £162.00 which can by paid with credit/debit card or cheque.
	Deposit varies depending on the size of the site and work being undertaken.
	The amount of deposit will be determined by a site visit from a Highways Inspector, the minimum amount of deposit taken is £500.
Q3.	Who is responsible?
Α.	We accept applications from builders on behalf of the landowner; however the land owner is ultimately responsible in making sure licences are in place.
Q4.	How do I apply?
Α.	Phone our First Contact Service on 020 8359 3000
	Please provide the company name, the site address, the date the works are commencing and expected completion date
Q5.	How long does it take?
Α.	We aim to send out the relevant documentation on the same day the application is received.
	The customer then has 5 days to return the paperwork to us with the necessary payment.
	Once the payment has been received the licence/ indemnity can be issued, upon approval of the Highways Inspector.
	Providing the documents and payments are returned promptly the process should take approximately 5-7 working days.
Q6.	Anything else I should be doing?
