

BEAM Initial Visit to home

BEAM facilitator and manager. Gather information and signpost to relevant services e.g. Earlybird, Local Offer, SENDIASS, Parent/Carer Forum.

Invitation to **compulsory parent group (N1 and N2 group)**

BEAM Nursery 1 Package

(3 months)

Two sessions per week x 1 hour. Delivered in the home and occasionally the Nursery. In the home, parents are expected to be present in the sessions.

- **Speech and Language Input delivered through Block clinic sessions.**
- If relevant concerns arise– refer to BEAM OT
- On-going Early Support and signposting to other services.
- Electronic weekly tracking sheet
- **Social Communication (JA &SU) part of the SCERTS assessment (at beginning of service and end of 1st year with BEAM)**
- **2 xEHCP reports (where necessary)**

BEAM Nursery 2 Package

(3 months)

Two sessions per week x 1 hour. Delivered in the home and occasionally the Nursery. In the home, parents are expected to be present in the sessions.

- **Speech and Language Input delivered through BEAM SLT including formal target setting and monitoring.**
- If relevant concerns arise– refer to BEAM OT
- On-going Early Support and signposting to other services.
- Electronic weekly tracking sheet
- **SLT complete Social Comm section of Barnet SCERTS assessment.**
- **BEAM Daily Activities target sheets**
- **Manager and SLT complete Barnet SCERTS assessment (at one point during service)**
- **2 x EHCP reports (where necessary)**

Route A

ONE session per week x 1 hour
(inc. occasional Nursery visits)
ALL of above

Route B

ONE session per week x 1 hour
(inc. occasional Nursery visits)
ALL of above

Summer Term (April to August/September)

Monthly visits. This is considered as a **period of consolidation.**
BEAM service still available for advice and support. Access to parent groups.

Summer Term: Transition to school Period

Package of support including 6- 8 visits across the term including preparation for transition to new Reception setting.

BEAM Parent Groups (monthly)

Barnet Multi-disciplinary parent group
(currently being developed)

Review referrals for children transitioning to school. Plan against their existing support from other professionals e.g PSTT.
