

# Early Years Foundation Stage

Barnet gender gap 2015: **15.7** (national 15.7) Barnet gender gap 2014: 14 (national 17)

Barnet gender gap has increased by 1.7 National gender gap has reduced by 3

Although there is no national data, internal Barnet data indicates the FSM gap for GLD has narrowed from 16.4 percentage points to 12.8 percentage points

Gender gap is **5 percentage points** (a **decrease on 2014** and smaller than national)

EAL gap is 6 percentage points (an increase on 2014 and wider than national), however, both groups attain above national counterparts

FSM gap is **12 percentage points** (same as 2014 and smaller than national), however national decreased from last year



## All SEN Groups attain above their national counterparts

The gap between SEN pupils (SEN Support, School Action, School Action Plus) pupils and non-SEN pupils is **36pp in Barnet compared to 37pp in 2014** (national 41% in 2015)



#### **GENDER Level 2B+ RWM**




Barnet's gender gap is 12 percentage points (an increase of 1pp from 2014)
National's gender gap is 12 percentage points (a decrease of 1pp from 2014)

Barnet's EAL gap is **7 percentage points** (an **increase of 1pp** from 2014)
National's EAL gap is 4 percentage points (a decrease of 1pp from 2014)


#### SPECIAL EDUCATIONAL NEEDS Level 2B+ RWM



## All SEN groups attain above their national counterparts

The gap between SEN pupils (SEN Support, School Action, School Action Plus) pupils and non-SEN pupils is **48pp in Barnet compared to 47pp in 2014** (national 54% in 2015)

# Key Stage 1 (FSM6)



The gap between Barnet's FSM6 pupils and national Not-FSM6 pupils narrowed to 17 percentage points in 2015
The internal Barnet gap has remained at 19pp (same as national, but national narrowed by 2pp from 2014)














Barnet's gender gap is **3 percentage points** (the same as 2014)

National's gender gap is 4 percentage points (an increase of 1pp from 2014)


## LANGUAGE % Level 4B+ (Re, Wr, Ma)

National's EAL gap is 5 percentage points (an increase of 2pp from 2014)


### SPECIAL EDUCATIONAL NEEDS % Level 4B+ (Re, Wr, Ma)



# All SEN groups attain above their national counterparts

The gap between SEN pupils (SEN Support, School Action, School Action Plus) pupils and non-SEN pupils is **43pp in Barnet compared to 44pp in 2014** (national 51% in 2015)

# Key Stage 2 (FSM6)




The gap between Barnet's FSM6 pupils and national Not-FSM6 pupils increased by 1pp to 11 percentage points in 2015

The internal Barnet gap has **narrowed** by 2pp to 14pp (national narrowed by 1pp to 19pp)



## Summary

- SEN pupils attain above national counterparts at Phonics, KS1 and KS2
- EYFS gender gap increased as girls' attainment increased more than boys'
- Gender and FSM gap in Phonics is smaller than national
- Gender and EAL gap at KS1 increased whilst national decreased
- KS1 FSM6 gap against national narrowed at Level 2B+, and Reading, Writing and Maths APS
- FSM6 gap against national at KS2 increased in Level 4B+ RWM, Writing progress and Maths progress
