What do I need to enrol onto GCSE English Language?

You will need to sit and pass an assessment which will examine your current levels of ability in reading and writing. You should be able to demonstrate reasonable skills in these areas which show you can study and pass at minimum Grade 4.

If you pass this assessment, you will be invited to enrol onto the GCSE English Language course. If you do not pass, you will be invited to enrol onto a Functional Skills English course which will improve your English skills and give you the opportunity to progress to GCSE English Language the following year.

Where and when can I study GCSE English Language at Barnet and Southgate College?

Courses are running from September 2018 at our Barnet Wood Street, Southgate and new Colindale Campuses. Classes are 3 hours per week (in one single class) and run on weekday evenings from 6:30pm and Saturday mornings from 10:00am. GCSE English lasts from September 2018 – June 2019.
